Welcome to Sue Ryder Care. Sue Ryder Care Thorpe Hall Hospice has been successful in obtaining a grant from the Department of Health under the 'Privacy and Dignity' umbrella, and therefore we have relocated to Stamford Hospital while essential maintenance work is carried out. The maintenance work will take between 12-24 weeks to complete, after which we will be returning to Thorpe Hall hospice. We will open the inpatient unit at Stamford Hospital on 5 January 2009.

By car: Stamford & Rutland Hospital is situated on Ryhall Rd in the town centre, next to Morrison's supermarket. Follow signs from the town centre. **Parking - there are** approximately 200 spaces at the hospital. Patient and Visitor parking is accessed from Ryhall Road. Parking is free.

By bus: There is a bus service which runs from Stamford Bus Station to Stamford Hospital, the numbers are: 10 - 182 - 201 - 202 - 302 - 310 - 604 (33 - Saturdays).
