








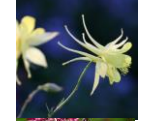

Category	Plant	Aspect: sun (s), part shade (ps), shade (sd)	Height (mm)	Spread (mm)	Description	Photo
Bulb	<i>Allium 'Hair'</i>	s, ps	600	100	An unusual allium which has purple red bulbils that sprout green wispy "hairs"	
Bulb	<i>Allium schubertii</i>	s	600	300	One of the largest-headed ornamental alliums. Each individual flower opening at different height producing a firework-like effect with umbels of 50 or more star-shaped, pinky-purple flowers on stems of differing lengths produce a starburst effect	
Fern	<i>Blechnum spicant</i>	sd	500	450	Over time, the feathery, dark green fronds of this handsome, evergreen 'hard fern' spread semi-horizontally to form an attractive, rosette-like shape. The fern provides all-year interest for shady areas of the garden	
Fern	<i>Polystichum setiferum</i> 'Plumosom Densum'	ps, sd	400	300	An elegant little form of soft shield fern bearing densely-packed, lacey evergreen fronds	
Fern	<i>Polystichum setiferum</i> 'Herrenhausen'	ps, sd	1000	1000	Herrenhausen is a semi-evergreen fern. The new foliage uncurls in spring to show long, intricately-divided fronds up to 1m in height	
Fern	<i>Polystichum tsussimense</i>	s, ps, sd	500	500	A reliable fern with glossy, upright, darkly veined fronds and a delicate spine-pointed tip for shadier spots and underplanting	
Grass	<i>Deschampsia cespitosa</i> 'Palava'	s, ps	1200	1500	Forming evergreen tussocks of stiff, mid-green leaves, which are topped by open, arching sprays of silvery-purple spikelets throughout the summer. This marvellous grass will flourish in sun or light shade in reliably moist soils	
Grass	<i>Melica uniflora</i> 'Alba'	s-ps	600	600	A quietly attractive grass for shade, including dry shade. Of interest all season, with buds that look like tiny grains of rice creating a dainty effect	
Grass	<i>Sesleria heuffleriana</i>	s	450	450	A densely tufted, evergreen grass, with an upright habit and narrow, bright green leaves in spring, becoming blue-green with silvery undersides in summer. Flowers are produced early in spring, with slender stems bearing dark purple spikelets opening to small white flowers	












Grass	<i>Stipa lessingiana</i>	s	600	300	Wonderful, wispy, pale yellow-green leaves topped with fluffy plumes of silver-green flowers, maturing to blonde-buff. This versatile semi-evergreen grass is ideal for a sunny gravel garden, large container or new perennial border
Perennial	<i>Acanthus mollis</i> 'Rue Ledan'	s-ps	1300	900	A rare form of acanthus with pure white flowers on silvery-green spires. Extremely elegant, bright and ghostly and invaluable for thriving in a north facing border
Perennial	<i>Alchemilla erythropoda</i>	s-light s	250	300	Forming neat, compact clumps of bluish-green leaves, which have notched edges and may take on a red flush when grown in full sun. The yellow-green flowers appear in small clusters from late spring and take on russet tones as they age
Perennial	<i>Alchemilla sericata</i> 'Gold Strike'	s-ps	300	500	Also known Lady's Mantle. Has bright greenish-yellow veil like flower umbels and velvety scalloped foliage
Perennial	<i>Aquilegia vulgaris</i> 'Green Apples'	s	900	400	A short-lived perennial growing up to 90cm with divided, dark green leaves. Pompom-like flowers, with narrow, pale green petals ageing to white, appear in late spring and early summer
Perennial	<i>Aquilegia chrysantha</i> 'Yellow Queen'	s-ps	900	450	Bright lemon yellow, upward-facing flowers with long spurs that flare out behind appear in early summer, and top clumps of ferny bluish-green foliage
Perennial	<i>Astrantia major</i> 'Sparkling Stars Red'	s-ps	400	400	An exceptional perennial, it has delicate, star-shaped, crisp-crimson blooms
Perennial	<i>Astrantia major</i> 'Sparkling Stars White'	s-ps	400	400	Bewitching bloom comprised of gleaming white bracts and dotted with a dome of little silvery flowers
Perennial	<i>Brunnera macrophylla</i> 'Sea Heart'	ps	400	450	Has bright green veining through frosted silver heart-shaped leaves, which are creamier when young, delicate sprays of 5-petaled, blue flowers. A mutation of <i>Brunnera</i> 'Silver Lace'
Perennial	<i>Cephalaria gigantea</i>	s-ps	1800	600	Strong branched stems carry primrose-coloured scabious flowers with greenish centres, intermittently all summer
Perennial	<i>Digitalis lutea</i>	ps	600	450	A vigorous plant, sending up tall spikes set with delicate narrow yellow flowers. A small yellow foxglove



Perennial	<i>Epimedium grandiflora</i> 'Lilafee'	ps	250	300	Has narrow, oval leaves, softly bronzed when young. From dark purple buds open long sprays of light purple flowers fading to white-tipped spurs.	
Perennial	<i>Erigeron karvinskianus</i> 'Lavender Lady'	s	300	1000	A cultivar of the much loved Mexican Fleabane with slightly larger, lavender coloured flowers	
Perennial	<i>Geranium</i> 'Azure Rush'	s-ps	450	600	Geranium 'Azure Rush' is a beautiful hardy geranium cultivar with pretty large, lavender blue saucer-like flowers with white centres held above divided mid-green leaves	
Perennial	<i>Geranium</i> 'Eureka Blue'	s, ps	500	600	Large true blue flowers on a well behaved, clump forming plant	
Perennial	<i>Geum</i> 'Mai Tai'	s	450	400	<i>Geum</i> 'Mai Tai' has branching, red-green stems on which pink-flushed, apricot flowers appear from late spring to summer	
Perennial	<i>Gillenia trifoliata</i>	ps	900	500	A charming perennial that bears masses of delicate, star-shaped white flowers in midsummer	
Perennial	<i>Lamium orvala</i>	s, ps	600	300	Handsome stems carry pairs of dark, pointed, strongly-veined leaves. Beneath each pair is a whorl of rich strawberry-pink lipped flowers.	
Perennial	<i>Lamium maculatum</i> 'Pink Pewter'	sd, ps	200	600	<i>Lamium maculatum</i> 'Pink Pewter' is a tough and resilient hardy perennial, thriving in shade on almost any soil. This vigorous dead nettle will form a carpet of sparkling silver foliage with deep green margins. and clusters of salmon pink flowers	
Perennial	<i>Lysimachia atropurpurea</i> 'Beaujolais'	s-ps	600	500	Crimson flower spikes, which look like tiny pineapples when they first emerge, above silvery-green foliage	
Perennial	<i>Molopospermum peloponnesiacum</i>	s-ps	1500	900	A clump-forming perennial to 1.5m high, with strongly scented, slightly glossy, finely divided fern-like leaves. Small pale yellow flowers are borne in domed clusters on strong upright stems in late spring and early summer	
Perennial	<i>Nepeta racemosa</i> 'Amelia'	s	600	600	Perennial with silver-green leaves and spikes of soft pink flowers	

Perennial	<i>Nepeta x faassenii</i> 'Purrsian Blue'	s	450	750	A compact herbaceous perennial forming a dense, rounded clump of foliage, with clustered periwinkle blue flowers
Perennial	<i>Nepeta grandiflora</i> 'Summer Magic'	s-ps	400	400	A compact catmint which holds its shape better than most. The aromatic, grey-foliage offers the perfect backdrop for its larger than average, nectar-rich flowers
Perennial	<i>Salvia microphylla</i> 'Delice Aquamarine'	s	1000	1000	A hardy, bushy shrub with dark green, oval leaves and delicate pale sky blue flowers with yellow spots on the petal edges
Perennial	<i>Salvia microphylla</i> 'Delice Gold and Wine'	s	1000	500	A hardy, bushy shrub with dark green, oval leaves and delicate dark pink and cream flowers
Perennial	<i>Salvia x jamensis</i> 'Nachtvlinder'	s	1000	1000	Nachtvlinder is a bushy plant, about 75cm tall, evergreen with aromatic, small, toothed mid-green leaves and dark maroon-purple flowers
Perennial	<i>Sanguisorba tenuifolia</i> 'Alba'	s, ps	2500	1000	Mounds of finely divided light green foliage and spikes of small catkin like white flowers during summer
Perennial	<i>Sanguisorba officinalis</i> 'Lum'	s, ps	800	400	A nice upright form, flowering from late spring onwards, small dark red-maroon flowers, which lighten with age
Perennial	<i>Sarcococca hookeriana</i> 'Purple Gem'	sd, ps	700	500	Bushy, rounded dwarf shrub with deep purple-red stems bearing glossy dark green foliage. During the winter months, buds open to vanilla-scented spidery cream flowers, followed by black berries in late summer.
Perennial	<i>Saruma henryi</i>	ps-sd	500	1000	A herbaceous perennial with branched, upright stems bearing pale green, heart-shaped leaves. The whole plant is softly hairy, giving it a silvery appearance especially in spring. Yellow, three-petalled flowers are produced at the branch tips intermittently from spring to summer
Perennial	<i>Syringa</i> 'Bloomerang Tiny Purple'	s	400	300	Common name Lilac. Highly fragrant panicles of deep purple-pink blooms will appear above the mid-green, ovate leaves
Perennial	<i>Tellima grandiflora</i>	s, ps	800	300	Large, attractively veined, rich green leaves. Similar to heuchera it stays low, with flower stalks rising well above



Perennial	<i>Thalictrum</i> 'Black Stockings'	s-ps	1200	900	A tall, herbaceous perennial with lacy foliage and upright, near-black stems to 2m bearing generous sprays of fluffy, bright purplish-pink flowers	
Perennial	<i>Tiarella</i> 'Running Tiger'	ps, sd	150	400	White star-like flower spikes in late spring over attractive mounds of pale green foliage with maroon overlay	
Perennial	<i>Valeriana officinalis</i>	s	1450	450	A clump-forming herbaceous perennial. In summer the fleshy stems are topped with rounded clusters of small pink or white flowers.	
Perennial	<i>Zizia aurea</i>	s, ps	1000	500	An herbaceous perennial to 80cm tall, with upright, branching stems and toothed, glossy, pinnate leaves. In late spring and early summer it produces flattened umbels of bright yellow flowers; these are followed by purplish seed heads	
Rose	<i>Rosa</i> 'Mutalblis'	s	2000	2000	A very unusual rose. Continuously producing single, scented flowers of honey-yellow to orange, ageing to cerise red	
Rose	<i>Rosa</i> 'Roald Dahl'	ps	900	1100	<i>Rosa</i> 'Roald Dahl' has soft orange-red buds that open to medium-sized, cupped rosettes of perfect apricot colouring. They are extremely robust and have a lovely fruity tea scent	
Shrub	<i>Calycanthus</i> 'Venus'	sd	1500	1300	A deciduous, multi-stemmed shrub with glossy green leaves, up to 15cm long, that turn yellow-brown in autumn. From late spring into summer 'Venus' bears large, scented, magnolia-like, creamy-white flowers with yellow and purple central markings	
Shrub	<i>Euonymus alatus</i>	s, ps	2000	2000	A large, spreading, deciduous shrub, the branchlets often developing conspicuous corky wings. Leaves oval, turning rosy-crimson in autumn. Flowers small, greenish, followed by purplish-red fruits splitting to reveal orange seeds	
Shrub	<i>Mahonia eurybracteata</i> 'Sweet Winter'	ps, sd	1200	1200	An upright, usually unbranched, evergreen, compact shrub to 1.2m tall. The dark green pinnate leaves have widely spaced, linear to narrowly lanced-shaped, gently serrated, but spine-free leaflets. The racemes of lightly fragrant, yellow flowers are produced from autumn to winter, followed by blue-black berries	
Shrub	<i>Paeonia</i> 'Canary Brilliants'	s-ps	1100	1300	Unusual, rare and highly collectable; intersectional peonies flower for much longer than other types of peonies. Gorgeous semi-double flowers opening pale lemon/cream and turning bright yellow with a splash of coral	
Tree	<i>Acer ginnala</i>	s, ps	7000	6000	<i>Acer ginnala</i> is a small, slow growing tree that grows to 7-10m in maturity. It flourishes in full sun or light shade, can withstand most soil types and has the added advantages of being wind and drought resistant	

Tree *Rhamnus frangula* 'Asplenifolia' s, ps 4000 3000

Black Alder. Pale white flowers appear in clusters along the stems in late spring. Suited to hedging



Tree *Tilia henryana* s, ps 20000+ 8000

A spreading, deciduous tree eventually reaching 25m in height, with broadly-ovate bright green leaves to 13cm long, softly downy on both surfaces and edged with bristle-like teeth. The leaves often emerge red-tinged, then turning yellow in autumn. Clusters of fragrant, creamy-white flowers are borne in late summer and early autumn
